Big Brothers Big Sisters has a clear mission of enabling life-changing mentoring relationships that ignite the power and potential that already exists within young people. Through the facilitation of mentoring programs for over 350 children and youth each year in Saint John, Kings and Charlotte Counties, BBBS ensures that young people benefit from critical relationships that build social-emotional skills, improve mental health and well-being and increase school engagement and employment readiness.

Our mentoring programs include both one-to-one and group programs, in school and in the community. Programs include Big Brothers/Sisters, In-School Mentoring, In-School Teen Mentoring (Teens as Mentors) and group programs such as Go Girls and Game On. Our Mentor Links program is offered for children who are on the waiting list for a one-to-one match and the PROPEL Program offers mentoring in career and post-secondary readiness for youth 16 to 24.

We are proud of the work we do and we are asking you to consider supporting our efforts by agreeing to become one of the event sponsors as outlined in the next few pages. Our mission of creating and supporting one-to-one mentoring relationships to ignite the power and potential of young people does not decrease because of this pandemic. 
